Notes

Line 3. In the manuscript the final word is written E^{nc} , instead of $\mathsf{C}\mathsf{E}^{\mathsf{nc}}$.

Line 5. In this line and throughout the song, the words for tigers and lions are written $C_{\parallel} L^{\circ} J_{\perp}$ and $C_{\parallel} L^{\circ} \dot{\dagger}'$ respectively, instead of $C^{\parallel} L^{\circ} J^{\perp}$ and $C^{\parallel} L^{\circ} C\dot{\dagger}'$.

Line 10. The word \mathring{l} ', "to whet" is incorrectly written $\mathring{\neg}$.

Line 20. The word $\mathsf{E}'_{\mathsf{ol}}$, "to move" is incorrectly written $\mathsf{E}'_{\mathsf{ol}}$.
