M386 A song about head-shaving.

Sung by Zhang De-jiu from Hmao-lo.

Notes.

This song is recorded in Document F (no. 14, page 12).

Line 4. The word Δ° , meaning "black", is a reference to the dark stems and foliage of the buckwheat. The flower is bright pink.

Line 5. The word \mathbf{J} ' means "food", but more particularly provisions for a journey. Buckwheat might be cooked and eaten just like rice or maize meal, but it was also made into heavy round cakes, ideal, if rather dry, rations for a journey.

Line 36. In this line $J_{\cap} C\Delta_{\overline{\sigma}}$ means "waves" or "ridges", and $\mathbf{J}^{-} CJ_{\circ}$ means "crowd", "herd" or "flock". Since $\Lambda^{\overline{\sigma}}$ means "to fly", the line is presumably a metaphor comparing the waving of the ripening corn to the flapping of the wings of a flock of large birds in flight.
